arlton Evans made his first knife some forty years ago. He and his wife live and work in the mountains of Fort Davis, Texas. He refers to his knife shop as the only mile-high knife shop in the state of Texas.

For his knife blades, Carlton offers a variety of premium steel options such as Stainless Damascus, 154 CPM, ATS-34. He hand cuts, hand shapes and hand finishes all parts of each knife. He designs and cut his blades using the "stock removal" method. This literally means removing material from a piece of steel using files, grinders, etc. until the steel has

the blade shape he desires. If the knife has a lanyard, the lanyard hole is fitted with one of Carlton's trademark handmade leather lanyards that sports handcrafted beads of what ever the handle is made from.

Carlton uses a wide variety of premium handle materials including giraffe bone, elephant, walrus or fossil mammoth ivory, exotic woods and several varieties pearls. He offers a series of knives designed with an African-related motif. He can even use material from one of your previous hunting trophies for your handle if he feels it is suitable. Such a custom touch makes a knife all that more of a personal.

Each of Carlton's knives is signed and numbered. Included with each knife is a Certificate of Authenticity. A beautiful handcrafted leather sheath is standard with each knife.
